 - Premium** is selectively used for high-profile spaces, such as reception areas, board rooms and executive areas requiring the highest quality of architectural woodwork
- Notify your AWMAC Chapter office that AWMAC's Guarantee and Inspection Service has been included in your project specifications (for contact information, visit AWMAC.com/GIS)

Our role in GIS

- Track the project from start to finish
- Inspect the architectural woodwork using trained and certified industry professionals
- Issue clear and concise reports to all parties during each phase of inspection
- Follow-up and ensure deficiencies are addressed

GIS inspections

Shop Drawing Inspection / Architectural woodwork shop drawings are inspected before manufacturing begins for compliance with AWMAC's quality standards.

Sample Unit Inspection / If specified, prior to manufacture of architectural woodwork, a sample unit is inspected either at the site or in the manufacturing facility.

Site Inspection / After installation, the architectural woodwork is inspected on site for compliance with AWMAC's quality standards.

- Confidence that the project will meet AWMAC's architectural woodwork standards
- AWMAC's two-year guarantee
- Quality architectural woodwork
