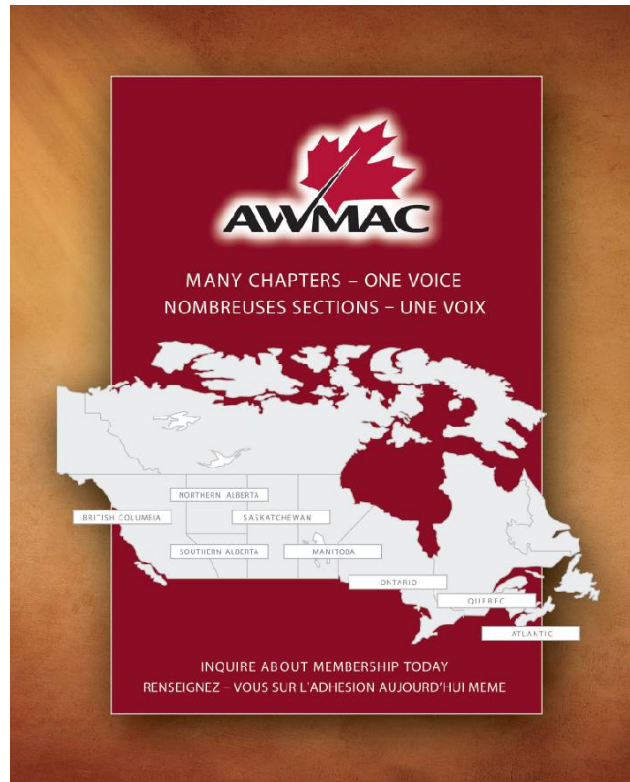
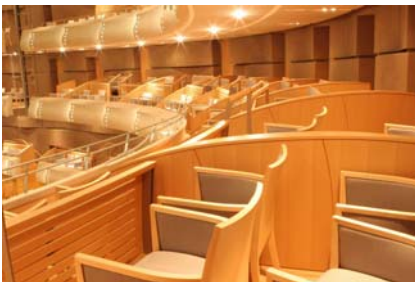


What is AWMAC?

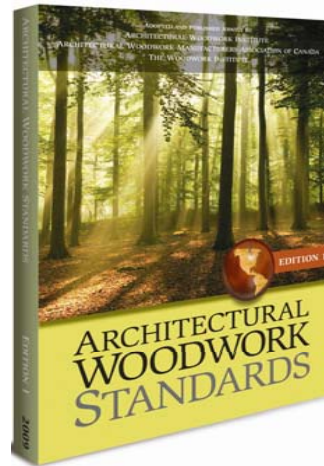

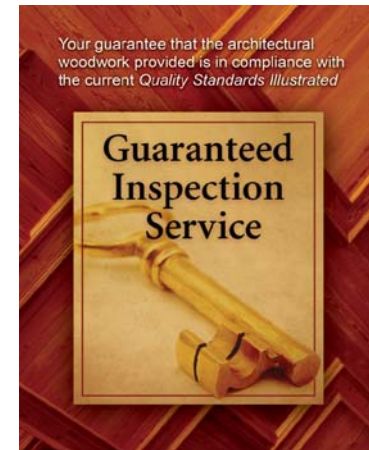
