



STUDENT STANDARDS EXAM (MSE) POLICY

1. WHAT IS THE SSE?

The Student Standards Exam (SSE) is administered by AWMAC and consists of multiple-choice questions to test a student's competency on the current AWMAC's STANDARDS¹.

To pass the SSE, a minimum score of 95% is required.

2. BENEFITS OF COMPLETING THE SSE?

- Gain familiarity of AWMAC's STANDARDS
- Receive recognition of successful completion (Certificate of Achievement)

3. WHAT IS THE COST?

- a. The SSE, including any upgrades or new SSEs, is FREE for students in approved woodworking and design educational institutions.

4. HOW DO I COMPLETE THE SSE?

- a. Visit www.awmac.com/examregistration and fill out the online form to request to complete the SSE.
- b. If approved to complete the SSE, you will receive an email with a link to the SSE for completion.
- c. If successful, you will receive an electronic Certificate of Achievement within five (5) business days.
- d. If unsuccessful, you may retake the SSE multiple times.
