- Encourage, promote, and participate in education sessions and programs that increase our industry stakeholders' knowledge-base and improve the level of certainty that a customer will receive the quality of architectural woodwork that is specified;
- Conduct business operations with integrity and respect business to business relationships; and,
- Treat diversity, inclusion and respect as a priority, and take action against discrimination or harm, while upholding equality and tolerance.
