



STUDENT STANDARDS EXAM (SSE) POLICY

1. WHAT IS THE SSE?

- 1.1. The Student Standards Exam (SSE) is administered by AWMAC and consists of multiple-choice questions to test a student's competency on the current AWMAC Standards¹.
- 1.2. In order to pass the SSE, a minimum score of 95% is required.

2. BENEFITS OF COMPLETING THE SSE?

- Gain familiarity of AWMAC Standards
- Receive recognition of successful completion (Certificate of Achievement)

3. WHAT IS THE COST?

- 3.1 The SSE, including any upgrades or new SSEs, is FREE for students in approved woodworking and design educational institutions.

4. HOW DO I COMPLETE THE SSE?

- 4.1 Email exams@awmac.com to request to complete the SSE.
- 4.2 If approved to complete the SSE, you will receive an email with a link to the SSE for completion.
- 4.3 Upon successful completion of the SSE, you will receive an electronic Certificate of Achievement within five (5) business days.
- 4.4 If unsuccessful, you may retake the SSE multiple times.
